
Libra (September 23 - October 22)



The down side to this is that it has caused a major change in the music industry and where their emphasis lies. However, as difficult as it has become for the labels and managers and artists to keep selling, it has also made an artist's ability to perform live that much more important. It is for that reason that performers like Foo Fighters, Deadmau5, Odd Future and many of the bands on the jam scene garner such a strong and dedicated following. It's always fun to meet that guy at the show that's at his 47th show, though sometimes it can admittedly get a little ridiculous (this summer there was a girl at the Stone Pony Summerstage who was seeing Moe. for the 200th time!) but that brought up the question... why see the same artist so many times? The answer is often multi-faceted..."The atmosphere is great"..."I love (insert band member's name here)"..."Their music rocks!". The truth is, whatever the personal reason there are definitely some objectively sensible reasons to see the same artist over and over.

Different show every time:

No band plays the same set, does the same solos and has the same banter every time they perform. The vibe is different from night to night, the atmosphere is different from venue to venue and you never can tell when someone might choose to bust-out that surprise legendary cover.

Good music holds up:

I'd imagine that this exists all over, but especially being from New Jersey, everyone knows those parents who started seeing Bruce Springsteen in 1978 and haven't stopped since... the reason? Good music is durable, it stands up to the test of time and the shows hardly ever disappoint.

Artist support:

- 5.**DON'T** have any expectations. Just show up and let life happen. The worst that can happen is you never see this person again, so why not embrace the weirdness of the whole thing.




